

# Journal Response and Comprehension Rubric

## Success Criteria:

1. The student writes journal responses in complete sentences.
2. The student writes three or more sentences to answer questions.
3. The student responds to questions by self-questioning, retelling, predicting, or assuming the role of a character.
4. The student's experiences and opinions are clear.

## Scale:

### **Excellent 4**

The student completes the task with no major errors.

The student demonstrates a full understanding of the concepts.

### **Very Good 3**

The student completes the task with only a few major errors and some minor errors.

The student demonstrates a strong understanding of the concepts.

### **Fair 2**

The student completes the task with some major errors and many minor errors.

The student has difficulty understanding the concepts.

### **Poor 1**

The student fails to complete the task.

The student does not understand the concepts.
